Welcome

Instructors will greet children while parents sign their little one in. Parents will say goodbye as children find their friends and discover activities to become involved in.

Discover Time

Children will discover that they can make choices on where to play and learn. Activity centers to choose from include dramatic play, blocks, puzzles, Legos, books, writing, coloring, play dough, easel painting, sand and water tables. An instructor will guide students at a craft table. All of our centers are designed to foster creative thinking, problem solving, improve small motor skills, and develop math and science concepts as well as social interaction and language skills.

Clean Up Time

Children learn responsibility as they participate in cleaning and organizing their classroom.

Circle Time

Children gather as a group where they will participate in songs and finger plays. The weather will be discussed along with the date and the Pledge of Allegiance will be said.



Small Group Learning

Children will be divided into two groups, and an instructor will guide each group through a new learning activity.

Show and Tell

The Special Helper for the day will tell us about his/her "treasure", and it will be passed around. Children are encouraged to ask questions.

Snack Time

Children share a nutritious snack as well as work on social skills and conversational skills.

Library Time

A quiet time to look at books.

Large Motor Skills Time

These activities will take place in our gym, outside on the playground, or in the classroom doing activities such as soccer, hula hoops, balance beam, yoga, dance, obstacle course or scooters.

End of Day Circle Time

We will review our day, sing our goodbye song, and pass out folders containing important class room information.

Registration Information

Children must be appropriate age for morning programs by September 1, 2011. Birth certificates are required at registration time (Hospital & baptismal certificates not accepted). Children must be completely toilet trained. Training underwear and "pull-ups" may not be worn to class.

Payment Procedure

Refund Policy

Refunds requested prior to final payment deadline will be issued less \$50. After June 1st, refund requests will be granted half of the program fee, unless we are able to fill the vacated spot. In that case, a full refund will be issued, less \$50. No refunds will be granted after the first meeting of the program unless a valid physician's written excuse is submitted. Refunds for this reason will be pro-rated upon the remaining number of classes in the school year in addition to the \$50.
