APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE PUBLIC HEARING
PALOS HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS

- The Mayor called to order the Appropriation Ordinance Public Hearing of the City of Palos Heights City Council at 6:45 p.m. in the City Administrative Center, 7607 W. College Drive, Palos Heights, IL

- Director of Accounting, Janice Colvin, addressed the proposed 2022 Appropriation Ordinance stating that the appropriation for the City is \$31,978,778 which represents a 4.6% increase from last year. The Library has appropriated \$3,799,871. The total appropriation is \$35,778,649 which represents an overall increase of 7.25%. The Library is conducting a \$1.3 million renovation with most expenses derived from special revenue reserves.
- Alderman Clifford inquired about the Library renovation. Jesse Blazek, Library Director, addressed the renovation stating that the Youth and Teen Services Department on the second floor of the Library is being renovated in order to address security issues providing greater visibility to the area as well as general wear and tear to the floor along with better overall services. The construction project was bid out to several contractors with construction underway.
- There being no further questions or comments from the public the Mayor adjourned the hearing at 6:50 PM.
