A message from Mayor Straz:

Governor Pritzker announced the State is ready to move into Phase 3. Most previously closed businesses will be allowed to reopen May 29th – with restrictions. Restaurants will be permitted to open with outdoor seating only. CDC safety guidelines will be followed.

Beginning June 1st, City Hall will reopen and resume normal business hours. Other city services, such as: Recreation Center, Library, and Lake Katherine Nature Center will be open with limitations. Please call ahead or check the website for information.
